Eligibility: Grades: K through 6th Grades

All posters must be submitted by a local CGCI club. The local Garden Club Awards Chairman will send the top three (3) in each grade. Sponsoring garden club may be that of a grandparent.

Rules:

1. A CGCI award application must be completed and submitted with entry.
2. Poster size: 8 ½ x 11" and must showcase one of the many pollinators.
3. May put multiples of the same pollinator on the poster but not different pollinators.
4. On the top right-hand corner **on the back of the poster**, in a space 3" x 4", write artist's name, grade, sponsoring garden club, and state. Do not use dark marker as the ink may bleed through to the front of the poster.
4. Entries will be judged on originality, design, creativity, and artwork.
5. Crayon, poster paint, watercolors, pencil, markers, etc. may be used.
6. The color, type and texture of the paper used is up to the creator.
7. Poster may include artwork that is pasted on a second piece of paper, but the entry must be flat – no 3D allowed.
8. Original entries will not be returned and become the property of CGCI and PRGC.
