

VISTA GARDEN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

THE PURPOSE of Vista Garden Club's Scholarship Program is to provide a scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 each year to a qualified applicant majoring in one of the following fields of study: Agronomy (soil management), Floriculture, Horticulture, Landscape Design, Botany, Forestry, Wildlife Science, Plant Pathology, City, Rural & Urban Planning, Habitat or Forest/Systems Ecology, Environmental Conservation, Land Management, and Environmental Concerns.

1. The applicant must be a full-time student.
2. The applicant must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 point scale).
3. All material must be computer generated and include all required documents as outlined below.

 - Proof of acceptance to the university of choice, including Admissions phone #
 - **Deadline: April 30th**
 - Notification Scholarship winner by May 31st

All applications will be judged on the following point system:

Academic Record – 50%

Applicant's Personal Essay – 35%

Listing of Honors, Work Experience, Extra-curricular activities – 15%
