2023 CGCI AWARD JUDGING GUIDELINES Awards Year: January 1, 2023 to December 31, 2023 Award Applicants' Deadlines: December 1, 2023 & January 10, 2024.

NEW THIS YEAR: All entries, except for Youth Contents, will be emailed to Emily Troxell (for flower show awards), Lisa Cosand (for youth award #65), and Pat Clayes (for all other awards). These chairmen will store the email with attachments (Award Cover Sheet, Award Application, etc.) on their computers and forward the email (with attachments) to the judging chairman.

Applicants are no longer required to submit an evaluation form. Judges will print and complete an evaluation form for each entry that they receive. The evaluation forms will be returned to the applicants at convention.

After judging, send Judging Reports and evaluation forms to CGCI Awards Chairman Pat Clayes, 72946 Ken Rosewall Lane, Palm Desert, CA 92260 or email to patclayes@aol.com. Judging Chairmen's deadlines are January 3 for all awards with a December 1 email deadline and February 15 for all other awards.

Award Judging Chairmen must:

1. If possible, find two other knowledgeable garden club members and hold a judging session. Be kind! Be nice! Be fair! Always make a positive comment and constructive comments (if warranted) on the back of the evaluation form. Always put the positive comment first.

2. Complete a judging report for each award, section, class, etc. Please use legible handwriting or typing. Please (if possible), no ties for placement awards (first, second, third and HM)—find a way to have one first, one second, one third and one HM, if that's what the award calls for. You can use decimals to deduct points -e.g., minus .0125 (1/8), minus .25 (1/4), minus .5 (1/2), minus .75 (3/4).

3. Retain a copy of the Judging Report for your records.

4. Mail or email evaluation forms and Judging Reports to Awards Chairman Pat Clayes -- see address above. See your deadline above (January 3 or February 15) to email or mail to Pat.
