There is a Starbucks 0.2miles, a 4-minute walk (just across the street), from the hotel. A Chick-fill-A and an In-N-Out are also close by. Across the freeway is Brookfields Family Restaurant. Also close by is a Target, I-Hop, and Jack in the Box just too mention a few. A more detailed list will be available upon check-in. Since we all enjoyed having some meal choices on our own, at Harris Ranch we have given you **two lunches, Monday, and Wednesday,** when you can decide where to eat.
