Burbank-Valley GC FIELD TRIP



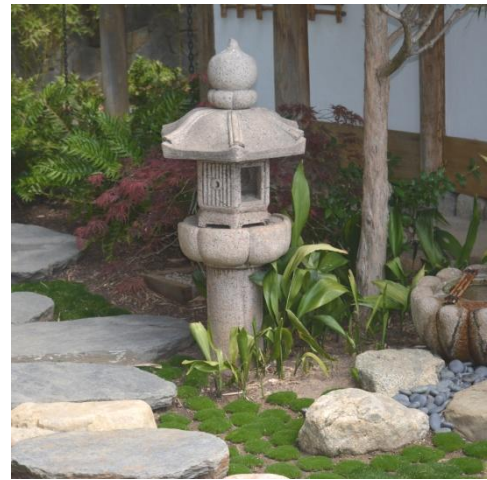

Our May field trip should see the spectacular azaleas and irises in full flower. We will spend about 1.5 hours in this garden before departing for our lunch destination at Green Thumb Nursery in Santa Clarita.

THE JAPANESE GARDEN at Tillman Water Reclamation Center and to **GREEN THUMB NURSERY** in Santa Clarita

Our bus departs at 9:00 a.m. from Little White Chapel, 1711 N. Avon, Burbank. Bring your own lunch; water and dessert provided by the Club. Cost: \$20 per person. Bring check or cash to April meeting. Or **before April 30** mail your check payable to Burbank-Valley Garden Club to treasurer Ingrid Nonnast, 907 N. Clybourn Ave, Burbank, 91505. You may also pay via VENMO – be sure to include the hyphen in Burbank-Valley Garden Club.

The Tillman Water Reclamation Plant treats more than 20 million gallons of San Fernando Valley sewage every day. The treatment is to the highest stage so the recovered water is safe and suitable for agriculture and for release into the Los Angeles River where it sustains bird and fish life year round.



At Green Thumb Nursery we will eat our lunch together in their garden pavilion. We will each have packed our own picnic lunch. Water and dessert will be provided by our Club.

At 1:00 p.m. John Windsor of Green Thumb Nursery will speak on integrated pest management to help us care for our gardens with minimal chemical use. And of course, you may shop this wonderful nursery before we return home.

The bus will depart for Little White Chapel approximately 2:30 p.m.
