April now teaches horticulture skills to youth detained at the County Probation Department's Youth Transition Campus. She leads a group of San Diego Master Gardeners, guiding troubled young men and women in growing plants while cultivating character. She is a self-taught gardener who has gardened throughout her career to relieve stress. In 202l, she began working at her parents' vineyard, gaining knowledge of grapes and how to cultivate, prune, and watch for pests. She became a Master Gardener in 2023, and her primary areas of focus are food production and orchard and vineyard maintenance.
